### Review of 2019/20

Total amount of Grant received = £18,000 + £5296 (Covid underspend)

### Priorities for 2020-21

- Continue to use (and try to utilise more) local sports clubs and coaches to support the quality of teaching and learning. Expert coaching delivered alongside the class teacher.
- Encourage teachers to use the new PE scheme of work with help from GetSet4PE through staff CPD.
- PE clothing for staff so we have a cohesive school look.
- Track and assess pupils' swimming ability to ensure we have a clear record of who can or can't swim 25m (2 lengths of our pool would be 30m).
- Provide additional swimming sessions for any child not on track to swim 25m by the summer term of Year 6.
- Maintain high level of clubs and extra-curricular activities (currently 13 sports clubs offered each week) - maintain registers as a record.
- Maintain high level of participation in inter school competitions.
- Maintain and increase opportunities to link with local sports clubs and sports scholarships to secondary schools.
- Ensure there is a clear pathway to identify talent and help parents join local clubs.
- To ensure sports equipment is fit for purpose and enables the curriculum and clubs to be delivered effectively.

£2715	Maudesport PE equipment	All new equipment ordered for the new scheme of work.	New scheme of work can be taught with the correct equipment therefore every child is included in the lesson.
£1710	Biking	Year 5 and 6 biking lessons to ensure they can all ride a bike by the time they leave in Year 6.	Pupils who could not previously ride a bike now can and many of them have the confidence to cycle to and from school on their own.
£297	Dance teacher	Specialist dance teacher for the production dances and then for PE lessons.	Pupils are able to learn choreographed dances for shows as well as accessing the dance curriculum within their lessons.
£200	PE conference and supply cover	Head of PE attended PE conference to subsequently change their scheme of work and update it.	Whole new PE scheme of work written for the school to include more of a variety of sports.
£360	Staff training - cricket for girls.	Two teachers attended Lydia Greenway training and updated their knowledge and skills.	Two teachers now have updated knowledge and skills to pass onto the children. Gave them the confidence to want to run a club and take the pupils to matches.
£9301	Specialist PE teacher	Teaches PE to the entire school for one of their timetabled PE lessons a week.	Each pupil has access to one PE lesson a week taught by a PE specialist.
£360	Scooter and Skateboard workshops	Gives the entire school the chance to have a go at new activities being introduced to the Olympics.	All pupils were able to participate in either a scooter or skateboard workshop. They were introduced to a new sport and lots have found they have the confidence to ride scooters/ skateboards outside of school.

£2484.32	Staff PE kit	All staff have a cohesive look when teaching PE and representing the school at sporting events.	Pupils can see that all the teachers are suitably dressed for PE lessons. When out on school visits and representing the school staff feel part of the St John's team.
£300	Sailing for Year 5 students	Two Year 5 students selected to attend 6 weeks of sailing to gain their Level 1 sailing qualification.	Two students now would like to become part of a sailing group and continue to pursue their interest in a new sport.
£985	Hever Schools Triathlon Day Year 5	Due to no PGL trip for Year 5 they participated in the Hever Schools Triathlon Day. They were able to learn about how the different disciplines within the triathlon and practise transitioning between them.	Some of them now would like to participate in the Hever triathlon using the discount code given to the school. Encouraged some non-riders to keep trying with their cycling at home.
£1160	Gazebos Sports Day	Purchased for Sports Day to ensure all pupils have some shade to be under.	Sports Day can now be held later in the term as all students can be protected in the shade given by the gazebos. Can also be used for interhouse games and at district sports in years to come.
£2656	New metal sports shed	New metal shed purchased to store sports equipment on the field and does not have to keep coming back up to school and being put away in the PE cupboard.	All staff now have access to the new shed on the field so are not restricted to only teaching PE lessons on the playground. Pupils will now be given the chance to learn a broader range of sports now all the equipment can be safely store and accessed.
